Scholarships for students at the Malmö Academy of Music

Applications are to be submitted via the application system by 3 May 2021 at the latest. Late applications or applications sent in a form other than that stated in the instructions above will not be processed.

You select the relevant application form in the application system. If there are several foundations and funds in the category (applies to string and the music education scholarships) your application is valid for all the foundations in the category. The Inga and Georg Kopelius Memorial Fund has several separate application forms.

Scholarships for students are paid into private bank accounts. Payments to people who work at the Malmö Academy of Music are made to the Malmö Academy of Music.

The allocation of scholarships is decided by the management group of the Malmö Academy of Music.

Academy of Music – Vocal

The Rosendahl Sisters' Vocal and Music Scholarship (92018)

Purpose: Two vocal scholarships of SEK 10 000 each are granted annually to one female and one male student.

Academy of Music – Piano

The Sven Fredriksson Piano Scholarship (92015)

Purpose: Scholarships to support talented, ambitious students' education in piano playing.

Academy of Music – Brass

The Sten K Johnson Music Scholarships (92002)

Purpose: Scholarships to students in the brass field at the Malmö Academy of Music. The scholarships are intended to reward particularly good study performance. The scholarships are preferably to be used as education scholarships, travel scholarships or as contributions towards instrument purchases. The brass board through its chair and in cooperation with the donor/foundation participates in the processing of nominees for scholarships.

Academy of Music – String

The Marianne and Lars-Anders Linder String Scholarship (92340)

Purpose: For students in the string programme at the Malmö Academy of Music.

The Lars and Gudrun Christensen Memorial Scholarship (92327)

Purpose: To one or more students at the Malmö Academy of Music. In the allocation of funds, consideration shall be given to ambition, talent and needs, and preference is given to violin and cello students.

Academy of Music – Music Education Scholarships

The Brita Nilsson Fund (92346)

Purpose: Scholarships primarily for prospective music teachers.

The Märta Klang Scholarship Fund for Music Students (92331)

Purpose: Scholarship for students at the Malmö Academy of Music.

The Elsy Jönsson Fund (129602)

Purpose: One scholarship per academic year for students at the Malmö Academy of Music.

The Inga and Georg Kopelius Memorial Fund

Purpose: To promote and support young people's music education in general and particularly good study performance. The scholarship can be applied for by students at the Malmö Academy of Music who are 28 or younger. The Malmö Academy of Music has decided that the scholarships from the fund are to go to:

- Organ playing. The scholarship is intended for students in the church music programme. (Application form: "Inga och Georg Kopelius – orgel").
- Guitar playing, focusing on western art music. The scholarship is intended for guitar students. (Application form: "Inga och Georg Kopelius – gitarr").
- Music education scholarships. The scholarship is intended for students training to become music teachers. (Application form: "Inga och Georg Kopelius – pedagogic").
- Projects to promote young people's music education. This scholarship is intended for groups of students. (Application form: "Inga och Georg Kopelius – project").
