

ENTRANCE HOSTS – CHECKLIST

CHECKLIST FOR ENTRANCE HOSTS

Wear representative clothing and always have your LU-card visible.

Before the concert:

- Take note of all emergency exits and make sure there is free passage to all of them. Evacuation signs must not be covered.
- Make sure you know where the fire extinguishers are placed.
- \circ Make sure you know where the accessible toilets and elevators are.

Letting the audience in at the main entrance:

- Make sure the entrance door is open and under constant supervision.
- Show the attendants to the concert hall.
- Take note of any attendees who need special attention and help in case of an emergency.

After the concert:

- Make sure everyone in the audience leaves the building.
- Make sure all doors are closed and locked.
- \circ The alarm is activated at 11:00 pm (23:00), by then everyone needs to be out.

Fire

In case of fire, the fire alarm will sound. The alarm will also notify the fire department automatically.

- Help people evacuate through the nearest smoke-free emergency exit.
- Call 112 as soon as possible.
- If possible, try and extinguish the fire.
- Make yourself known to the fire department when they arrive. They will know what to do and how to handle the situation.

Broken or faulty main entrance door

If the main entrance door stops functioning during office hours, contact our service coordinator Brian O'Driscoll (040-32 54 15). If it is outside of office hours, contact the landlord's emergency line (010-478 79 79) alternatively contact the university security guard (046-222 07 00).

Water leakage

In case of a water leakage contact reception (040-32 54 59) or our service coordinator Brian O'Driscoll (040-32 54 15) during office hours .

If it is outside of office hours contact the landlord's emergency line (010-478 79 79).

Violent or threatful situation

Never expose yourself to danger. Call 112 immediately if you feel threatened. If the situation feels manageable you can also call the university security guard (046-222 07 00) for assistance.

In case of an ongoing crime always call 112.
